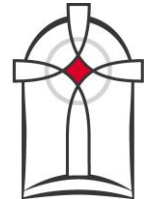

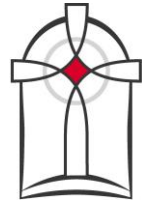
- No parishioners in attendance to address the Council

Information Sharing from Fr. Sean

- Deacon Kerry is at the Rehearsal for the Mass of Chrism. He will miss next month also because he is serving to assist the bishop for an event.
- Hired a new junior high youth minister - Kyle Hatfield (to replace Lauren Koath) Kyle will start in June 2016. Graduate from Steubenville. Young & committed. Married (wife from Austin) with a baby on the way.
- Holy Week - 48 new Catholics will be welcomed (there will be 20 baptisms at the vigil). Thankful and very grateful to all those who help with the liturgy and other events during this busy season.

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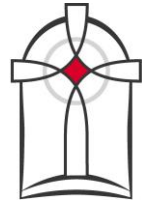
- Capital campaign kickoff was March 5 and 6th. Fundraising is close to 1,000,000 pledged. 1st week of April, receptions begin. Over 800 parishioners responded to help with mailings, calls, etc. Those 800 will be good ambassadors & supporters for the campaign.
- Finance council is reaching out to 10 banks/institutions. The diocese asked CtR to partner with an outside institution - splitting the loan between the diocese & an additional institution.
- Architects are working on actual plans now - ground breaking is still set for late summer.
- Feedback/questions on capital campaign & other topics:
 - Jason asked about security concerns as CtRCS grows: Plans are set to have fencing around the perimeter of the grounds when the new building is complete. New entrances with secure locks & cameras. A campus security officer would be an expense, but can look at the details once the school board is up & running. CtR driveways will also change when the new building is complete - this is for added safety for the school children.
 - James asked if there is possibility of any part of the construction being done ahead of time. This depends on renovations of the current building and timing. But 90% of the project is self-contained. In the current building, the old youth rooms (and pit area) will turn into 7 classrooms & 2 labs.
 - Thoughts on having children's liturgy at 2 Masses each weekend? Need volunteers to make that happen -- that's why the time alternates.

Other items

- PPC members will work 2 shifts for the two days of the Spring Festival on April 23rd and 24th. Sign up at this meeting. Fr Sean will share the sign-up sheet with the Finance Council, then Herman will also send it to PPCalums. If you are on the set-up shift you need to be there 1 hour early. Contact Herman if you need to add your volunteer hours. Other shifts at least 5 minutes early. 3 credit card machines will be available until 3pm on Sunday. A firm reminder: ONLY accept raffle tickets WITH money to put in the bin.
- Lisa is collecting \$20 from each PPC member for the auction basket -- please get that money to her ASAP if you did not make your donation at our meeting. Fr Sean will donate wine to the basket.
- Troy shared the idea of possibly having orange bracelets made with Mt 5:10 (Blessed are those who are persecuted) on them in memory of those who have been religiously persecuted. Fr Sean will talk to Fr John from POP and look into it.
- Ashley asked about Virtus Training and why it is required for adult ministries (i.e., the adult choir) - It is required for adult choir because 1 time per year they sing with the children's choir. CtR is now asking for training across all ministries. Required for those 18 and over.
