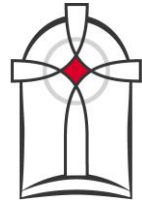

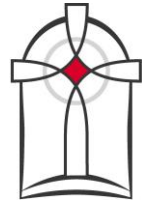

- Campaign Follow up
  - Finance council subcommittee is still working with the banks, taking care of finance proposals - making sure that payment terms are acceptable
  - Building plans currently with Harvey Construction are 90% done. CtR is going to look at other bids to make sure that we have competitive pricing. It is smart for CtR to look at different companies to make sure the comparisons are apples to apples and bids are competitive.

## Meeting Minutes - August 30, 2016



- Wanting to get to 4million pledged before breaking ground (hopefully in the Fall)
- New additions to CtR:
  - Deacon Jeff Willard - Director of Liturgy
  - Christy Wright - Director of Family Life - starts September 19. Margaret will help with the transition.
    - Fr Sean will invite them to one of the upcoming meetings so we can meet & welcome them.
- Air Condition. 2 blower motors in church went out - they have been replaced. The main unit for the CtR office is out - the replacement needs to be built - about 2 more weeks until it is replaced.
- Roof leak - still engaging the architects to figure out where the issue is coming from (the roof or the building). New leaks have been discovered.
- CtR school year is off to a great start. 392 students. Fr Sean enjoys his visits to the classrooms.
- The link to the budget is on the website - CtR is in good shape financially. Budget is tight, but CtR are on track. Finance council is very conscience and does a great job. The CAM monthly stipend is being bumped up a little. CAMs current campaign is up and going.
- Article on Catholic Trends - interviews with young people that had left the faith - as young as 10 making a choice to disengage from the faith. Shared this with the CtRCS staff since they are so influential. Fr Sean will share this article with the PPC, along with an article Fr Jeff Kirby wrote "Building for Business or Building for Mission?"
- Youth Ministry starts in September. Youth ministers are preparing and training volunteers.
- Genesis starts after Labor Day - full program with 240 students (and a waiting list).
- RE kicks off in September
- Parish Pilgrimage to Eastern Europe leaves on Labor Day - 79 people are going. Sept 5 - Sept 16
- Deacon Jay's wife has breast cancer and is extremely ill. Deacon Greg is doing much better - very active this past weekend at Mass & baptisms.

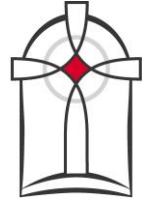
### **Other Items**
